

Graduate Center 2019 Faculty Scholarship Report

The 2019 faculty scholarship survey was sent to 171 central line faculty at The Graduate Center. 106 of those faculty are considered mandatory respondents (active in Spring and Fall 2019) and 65 were considered optional. A total of 125 faculty responded to the survey for an overall response rate of 73%. 102 mandatory faculty responded to the survey (96% response rate).

Highlights of 2019 scholarship:

- 850 works reported
- 24 authored or edited books
- 60 book chapters, introductions, prefaces, etc.
- 145 conference presentations
- 163 peer-reviewed journal articles
- 238 invited lectures

- Humanities produced 67% of the authored books, 82% of the edited books, and 58% of the book chapters
- Sciences produced 58% of the published conference proceedings and 43% of the peer-reviewed articles

- Top type of scholarship: Invited lectures, 30%
- Rate of scholarship: 9.3
- Survey response rate: 66%

Sciences Scholarship by Program/Facility

Highlights:

- Top academic program producing scholarship: Speech and Hearing Sciences, 32% of all Sciences scholarship
- Top type of scholarship: Peer-reviewed journal articles, 36%
- Rate of scholarship: 6.4
- Other notes: Many Sciences faculty appointed to a specific facility selected ASRC as their “Program”
- Survey response rate: 79%
