

MALS Travel / Research Grant Applications

MALS will be offering support for student travel and research for the academic year 2019-20. Students may apply for up to \$500 for domestic travel related to their research or to cover non-travel expenses related to their research. Students may apply for up to \$1000 for international travel related to their research or to cover non-travel expenses related to their research. Preference will be given to students who are working on research related to their capstone or thesis.

Examples of Research that might be funded are (but not limited to):

- travel to visit an archive, library, or historical society
- travel to participate in an academic workshop (Digital Humanities Research Institute, Rare Book School, for example)
- travel to conduct place-based research (for example, ethnographies or archaeological digs)

These funds cannot be used to present a paper at a conference, as there are funds available from the Office of Student Affairs. However, should attending a conference be essential to one's research, applications for attending a conference will be considered. The funds cannot be used to support the purchase of research materials, photocopies, scans or other materials.

Funding is available only to MALS Students. Students must be currently enrolled in the MALS program and in good status to apply.

Required application materials:

- A current CV or resume
- transcript
- A two-page application, outlining the purpose of the research purposed and the necessity of such research or travel to one's studies.
- A budget and timeline of proposed costs (please prepare in excel)
- The name and contact information of a professor who is familiar with your research project

Deadlines

Applications will be accepted three times during the academic year of 2019-20. November 1, February 15, and April 1. If there are not enough deserving applications, then funds will be rolled over to the next cycle to support additional internships.
